CIS allows PC workstations connected to LANs, WANs and the Internet to access clinical information from both local and remote data sources. Information from CIS is accessed via an internet browser giving users a common and familiar environment. CIS is designed to provide simple cost-effective distributed access to information held in multiple data sources. Users only require a machine with internet / intranet access and internet browser to access information.

Easy to set-up. Easy to use.

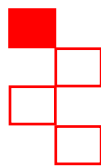
Setting up CIS does not take long since it can utilise the users existing browser and current domain login. So all that needs to be configured is the server!

CIS is easy to use, it is all mouse driven, user friendly and customisable to suit your needs. SPlus, since it is browser based there is no need to roll-out any software to the users desktop.

Interfacing

CIS provides an elegant method of interfacing to various data sources. Kestral has developed an application programming interface (API) specification that facilitates the development of suitable software drivers for different sources, such as:

- Patient admission/discharges
- PMI's
- Pharmacy
- Other HL7 interfaces.



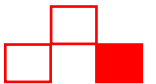

The technicals

Essentially, CIS is a combination broker/sever designed to manage the flow of information between data sources and any computer using a Web Browser with network access. A central Windows NT 4.0 / Windows 2000 Server running CIS Performs the broker functions between users requests and the data providers.
